

Girls on the Move 'GEARS'

Girls Education and Rider Safety Road Craft Skills Development Course



Girls on the Move (Got'M) was founded in 2003 and consists of a group of female motorcycle riders and enthusiasts.

It aims to provide a social network for female motorcycle riders and females interested in motorcycles. It also provides an opportunity for the sharing of information to enhance women's knowledge of motorcycling, support new riders and those returning to two wheels.

The name '**Girls on the Move**' represents women motorcyclists progressing towards increased confidence, knowledge and development of motorcycle riding skills.

In 2005 **Got'M** secured ACT Government funding to establish the **GEARS - Girls Education and Rider Safety** motorcycle roadcraft skills development course. In August 2007 **Got'M** obtained funding from the **NRMA – ACT Road Safety Trust** to continue the course into 2009. The course was developed by and is conducted by Stay Upright Motorcycle Techniques ACT and provides an opportunity to:

- allow for the review of current female rider training;
- provide advice on improving the delivery of training for women; and
- develop a road craft course that will include both theory and on-road training.

If you have been riding for at least 6 months and are keen to review your riding practices and road craft techniques then come along. The course is for women only and covers:

- Theory (why we do what we do)
- Participant Ride (metro & rural)
- Feedback and Review

We all need to be aware and responsive on the road. The course will raise your awareness of potential road hazards and help you develop strategies you can use everyday to maximise your safety on the road.
